



# EED Compliance Risk Map

Learn how EED Phase 2 will impact your organization

The **Energy Efficiency Directive's (EED) Article 8**, the energy audit obligation, affects 100,000+ businesses across Europe. National transposition has added country-specific rules, with some countries adapting to significantly different qualification principles, many beyond EU requirements. For multinational companies with operations across European countries, this presents significant complexity to compliance.

**Netherlands**

Temporary regulations for energy audit are causing many questions for Phase 2. Updates to legislation are expected in late 2019. Until then, enforcement remains with local authorities.

**United Kingdom**

Companies that match the ESOS Phase 2 criteria on **December 31, 2018** are required to measure energy consumption during the next 12-month period and report compliance by December 5, 2019, to their administrator.

**Sweden**

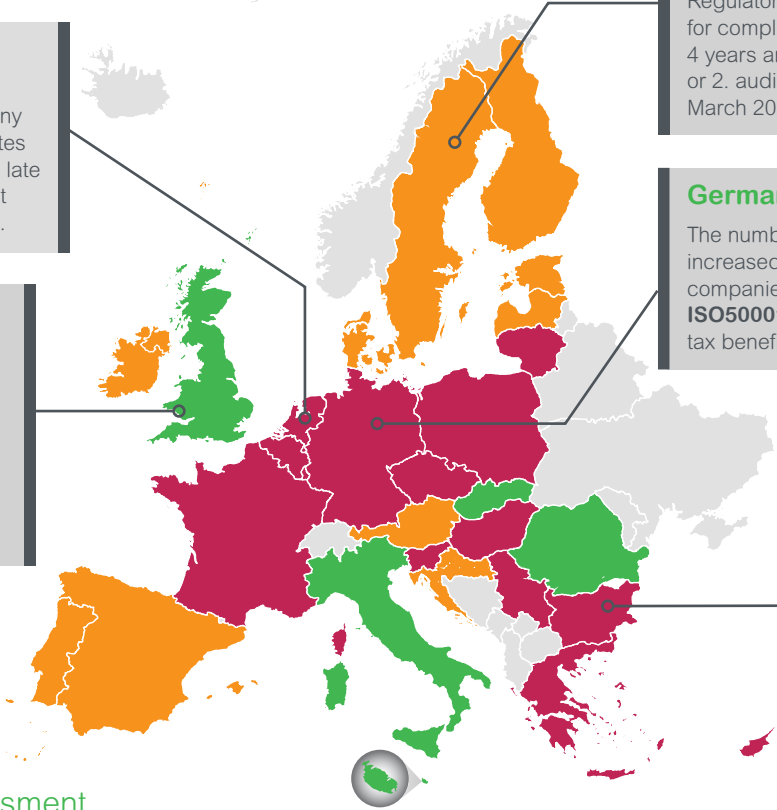
Regulators provided **two timeline options** for compliance: 1. Spread audits out over 4 years and report annually on progress, or 2. audit all facilities and report once by March 2021.

**Germany**

The number of EED-affected companies increased to 50,000+. However, many companies have complied using **existing ISO50001 certification**, gaining further tax benefits.

**Bulgaria**

Companies must now submit energy declarations and audit information on a **new web platform** by January 31 each year.



## About the risk assessment

For this map the compliance risk was defined based on the availability and firm establishment of country specific EED rules and the country specific level of enforcement.

- **HIGH RISK**  
Updated requirements after December 2015 and high level of enforcement
- **MEDIUM RISK**  
Updated requirements after December 2015 and medium-low level of enforcement
- **LOW RISK**  
No requirement changes after December 2015 and medium-low level of enforcement

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
